Now you can choose the right patient, choose the correct materials, plan the type and number of threads, and plan how to distribute the threads and which technique to use. However, remember that you still are not ready to apply the threads. The best doctor is not the one that knows only the theory, but the one who is the master in his skills.

NOTE: Aftercare is very important for every minimally invasive procedure including Scalp Threading. You will have all the information on what the patient should do after the treatment, when to start with the additional therapy and mostly when to expect the first results. If you have done a good diagnostic and planned the complete further treatment, you can also explain to the patient what are the expected hair regrowth results. Combining Scalp Threading with additional treatment is very important in order to achieve the optimal results. Minoxidil is a must. But how to combine Scalp Threading with other treatment options is intended for the Level 2 of the Advanced course.

That is also the time when you can proceed with the Level 2 Advanced course. Always remember the first rule: Primum non nocere.
